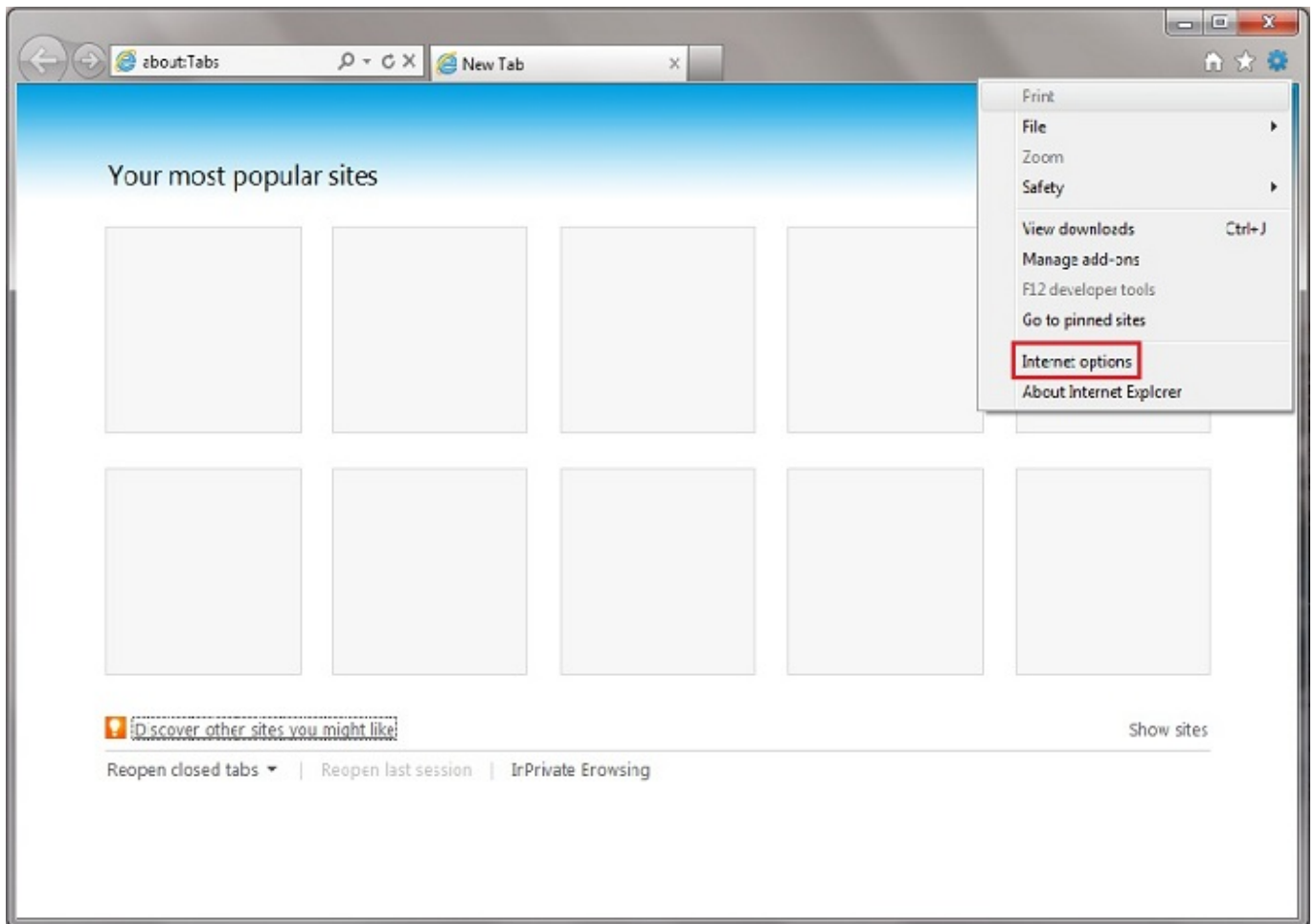

ActiveX Settings for Internet Explorer

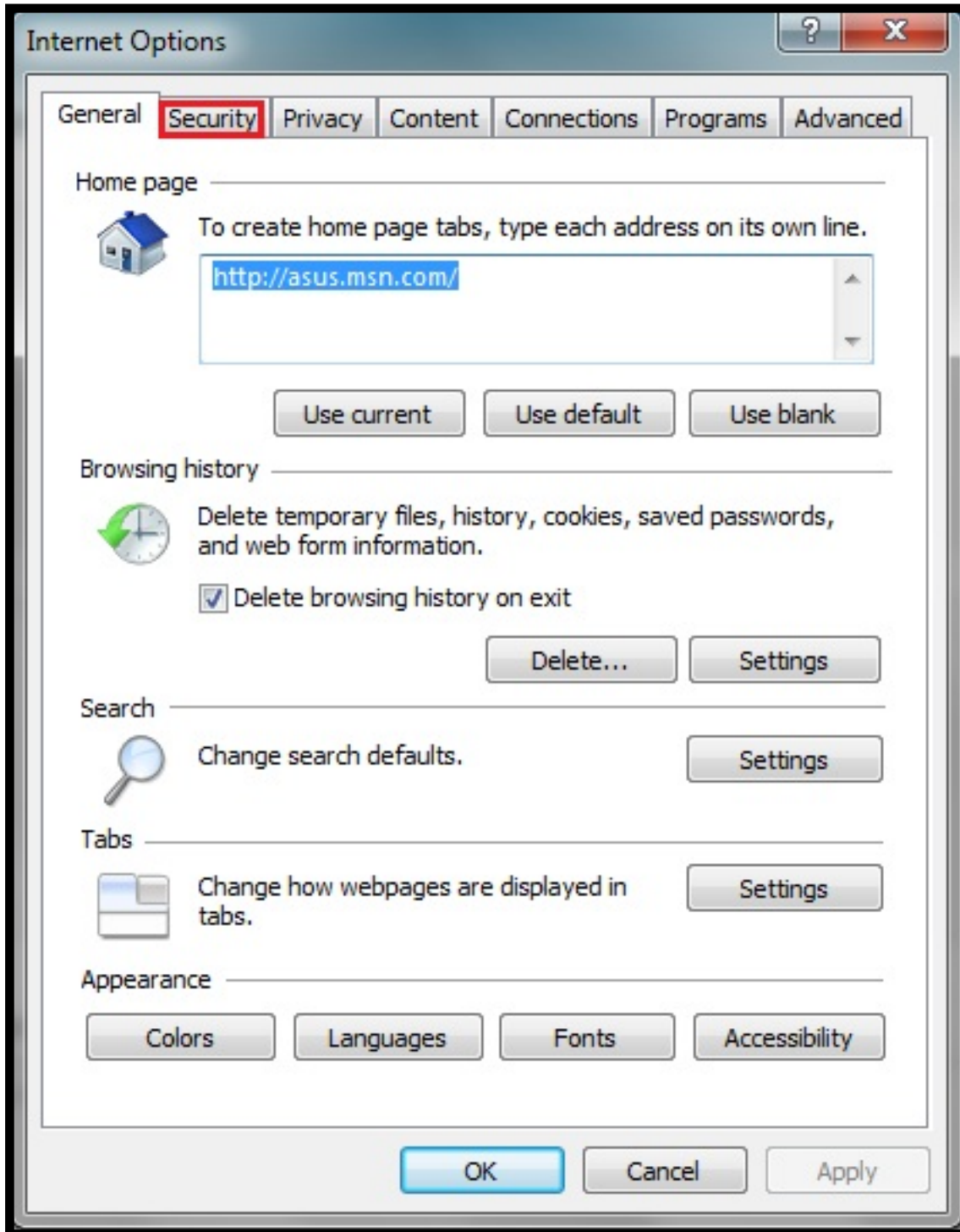
The first time you access any DVR system online (including the LiveDemo on Zmodo.com), you will need to change three [ActiveX](#) controls to "Prompt".

To change your ActiveX Controls, click on **Tools**, then select **Internet Options**.



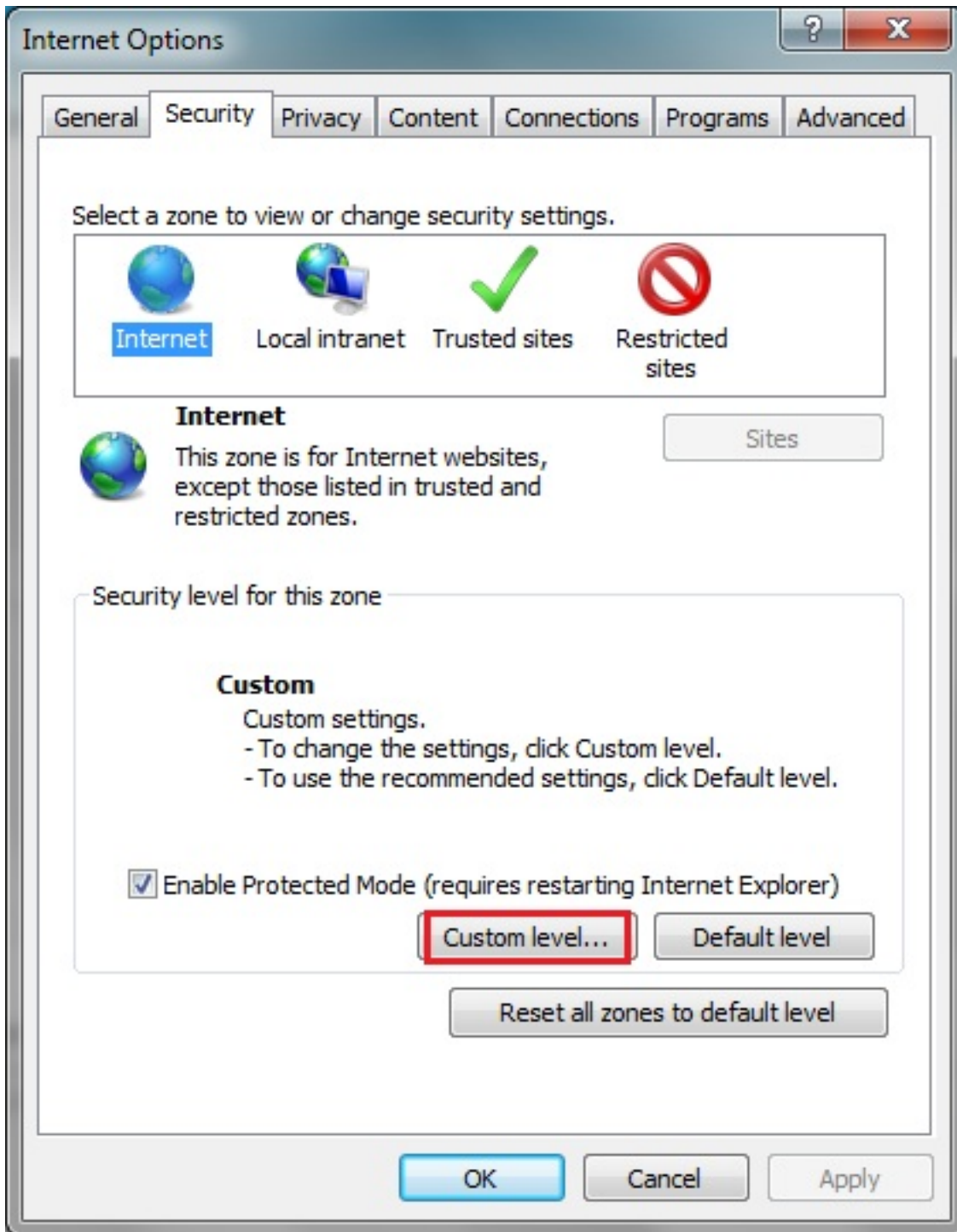
Once in the **Internet Options** menu, click on the **Security** tab.

From the **Security** tab, click on **Custom level...**

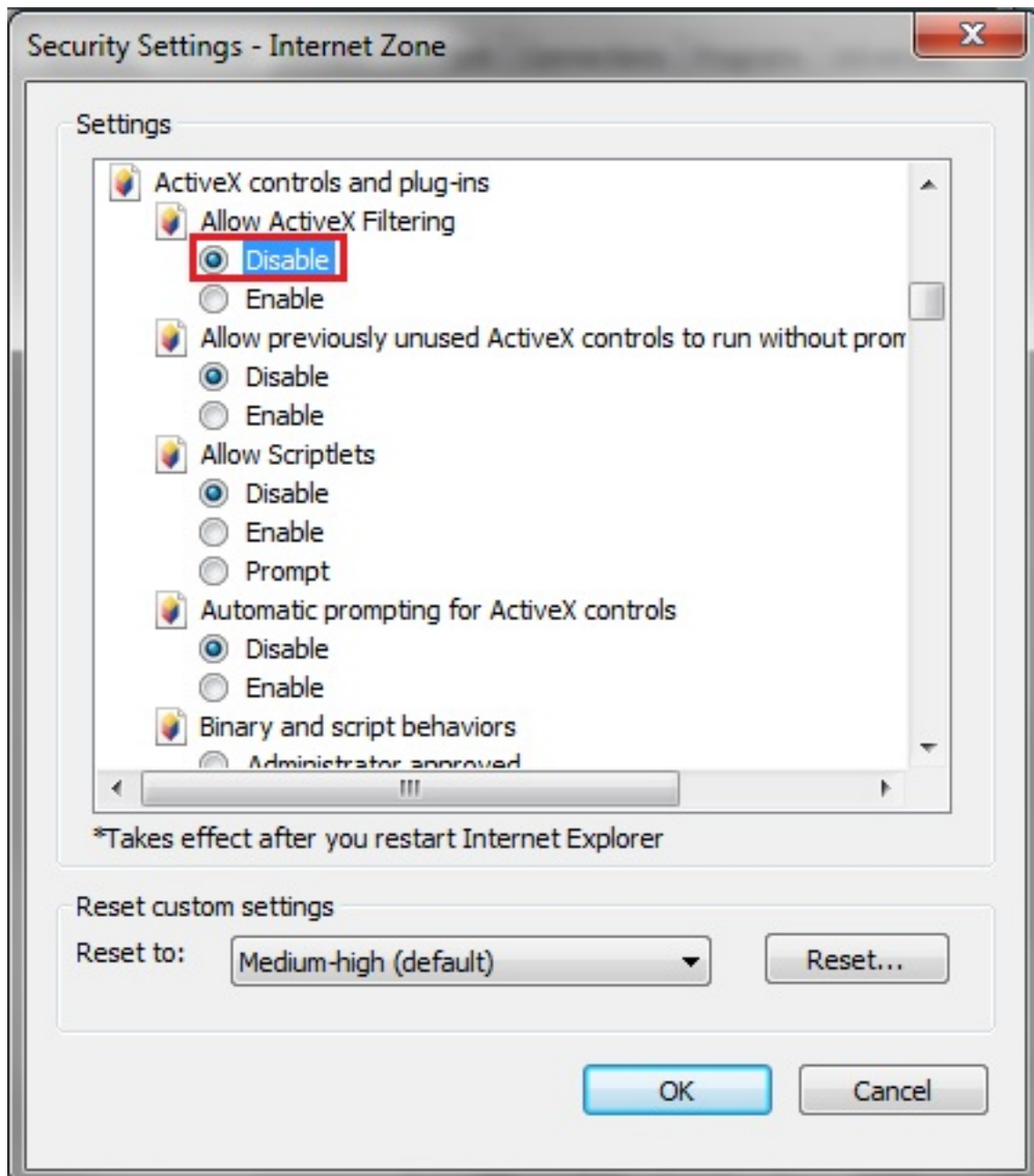

Scroll down until you see **ActiveX controls and plug-ins**.

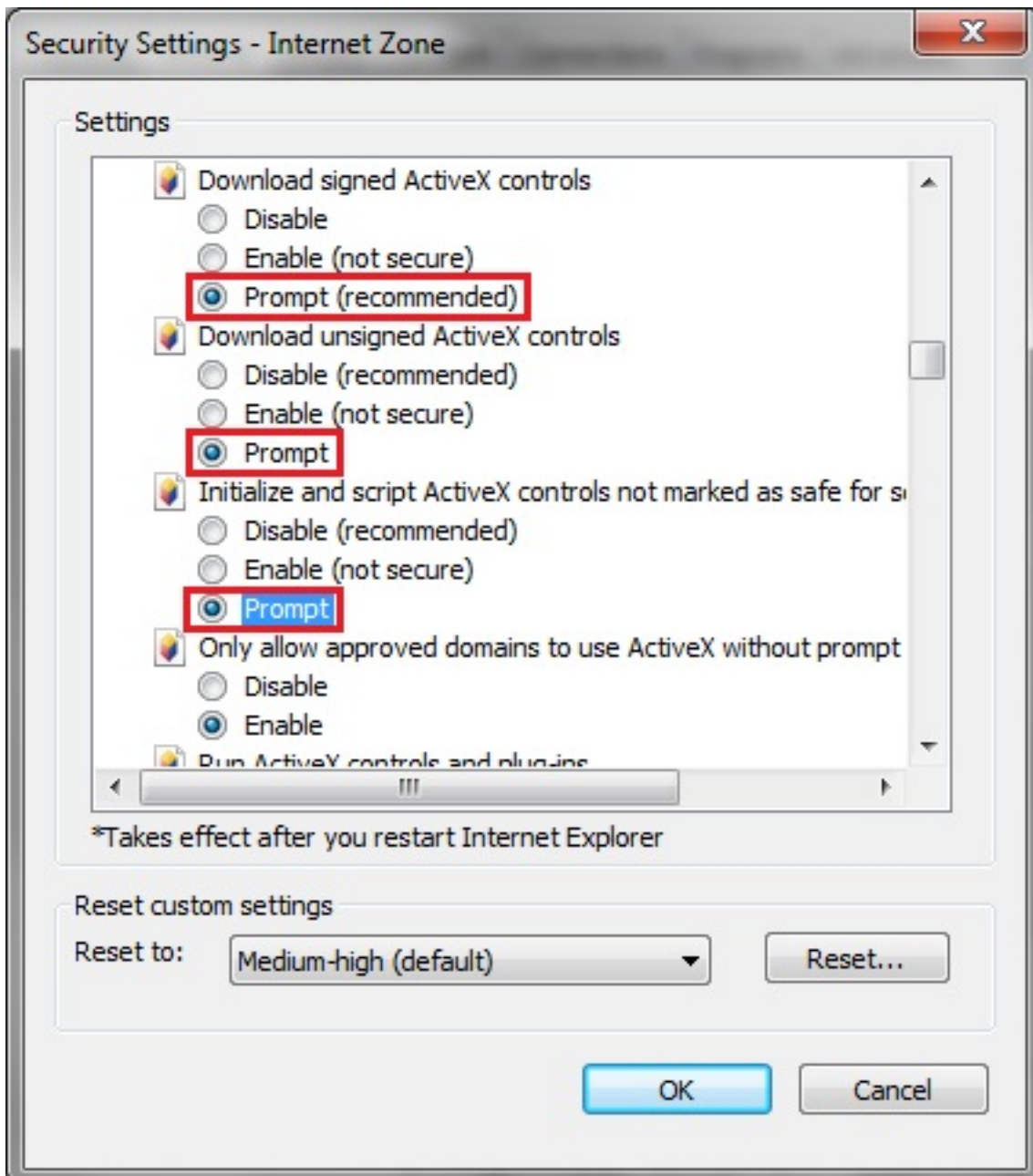
****For IE 9 users only:** For the first option, **Allow ActiveX filtering**, select **Disable**.



****For all users:** Scroll down farther through **ActiveX controls and plug-ins**, and change the following 3 values to 'Prompt':

ZP-NC14-P(720p PoE NVR)

- Download signed ActiveX controls
- Download unsigned ActiveX controls
- Initialize and script ActiveX controls not marked as safe for scripting

When done, click **OK** and exit the Security Settings menu.
