ZMD-DT-SCN8 How Do I Format the HDD On A SCN4, SCN8, and SEN6?

The SCN4, SCN8, and SEN6 will automatically format an HDD on boot up if it doesn't detect a format. While this guide uses pictures from an SCN4, it will be the exact same for the SCN8 and SEN6. It may be necessary to manually format an HDD for troubleshooting purposes.
